Hardware

We carry a large inventory on site, as well as being able to order and receive additional equipment within a few business days. Our large inventory is always up to date with a variety of hardware and software to adapt to any small business requirements. We stock many monitors, sizes 15 inch up to 22 inch, in either Flat screen LCD or conventional. With the dual output video card, two monitors can even be run in series for more visual workspace. The speed for these systems comes from either a Pentium 4 Xeon or AMD

Athlon processor mounted to select motherboards, able to accept any and all peripheral devices needed and desired (ie. Video card, network card etc.) To meet the storage requirements for business records and files, hard drives up to 150 GB are available. As always, as technology changes our inventory changes keeping up with new and powerful hardware

Software

On the operating end you will find that we will also meet your needs for powerful user friendly interfaces and software. We carry the latest in reliable and upgradeable software suites, and can actually create a software bundle specifically to your request. If unsure we will package it for you and finalize upon your satisfaction. These software bundles typically contain the operating system, networking client, maintenance utilities, troubleshooting, and any specialized applications necessary for your business management, development, and commerce. We carry Windows 2000 and Windows XP as the exclusive operating systems. Microsoft Server 2003 is the most up to date and reliable network client standard with the network setup. All of our network setups are protected by a virus protector and firewall. Your security and productivity are a top priority.

Service

Our standard service package includes the manufacture's warranty on equipment and an additional one year warranty from us. As well as tech support 9 to five, six days a week, and one house call per week. The consultation block hours for this plan are at the rate of \$80/hr. and a minimum of 20 hrs. must be purchased.

For a small additional fee upon contract payment you will receive our Premium service plan and upgrade package. With this plan you will be able to remain in unison with the changing technologies. We will graciously buy back your aging equipment upon request and put it toward the latest modern equipment. Along with that you will receive unmatched service and tech support going beyond our standard package. This means 24 hour tech support and unlimited service call if necessary. The consultation block hours for this plan are at the rate of \$60/hr. and a minimum of 20 hrs. must be purchased. The lower price in hours reflects both the higher fee you pay initially, and our encouragement to choose this plan.

For further assurance prior to delivery and installation, all of the hardware and components are thoroughly examined for defects and tested to insure proper and full working condition.

Networking

Our company offers three main types of network setups and cables. Our networks can usually be setup within one week of ordering pending size and material. Our technicians are all trained and networking certified and available to you at any time for questions.

Star Topology

Our most common setup is called the star topology. This setup looks like a star when it is all done. This setup has one line going from the computer or server into a central hub. The star topology uses the CAT5e cable. This is the most commonly used cable in small business networks. This cable can be used in single cable strands up to 328 ft. per line, with a transfer rate of up to 1000 mbps. The cost for the star topology is 15 cents per foot of cable. The hub cost is \$ 99.00 and the installation fee is \$225 up to 1100 ft. of cable.

Bus Topology

The bus topology is another type of setup that we offer. This setup has one main line that centrally located between the computers that are connect to the network. The computers then tap into the main line by converters. The bus topology uses the thicknet cable that can be used up to 1640 ft. per single line, with a transfer rate of 100 mbps. This topology is more expensive than the star topology but it can cover more distance and has a higher fault tolerance. The cost of the bus topology is 99 cents per foot of cable. The installation fee is \$400 up to 1000 ft. of cable.

Fiber Optics

Fiber optics is the last cable network that we offer. This network uses cable that transfers information by laser signals. This type of network is very secure and has the highest fault tolerance of all networks. Fiber optic networks are designed for very long distances. This network is highly recommended if you have to link two or more buildings together and they are located in different areas. The transfer rates for fiber optics is up to 2.4 GHz per second. The cost of fiber optics is \$2.25 per ft. up to 2.4 miles of cable, and \$2.75 per ft. over 2.4 miles. The installation fee is \$2000 up to 2.4 miles and \$3000 over 2.4 miles

Wireless

We also offer wireless network setups. The advantage of wireless is the lack of need to run all the cabling through out the company. Wireless has two main types that are offered.

The first type is called type B wireless. This has a transfer rate of 11mbps and coverage of 100-150 ft. inside and up to 300 ft. outside. This type of network uses 2.4 GHz frequency range and can be interfered with by 2.4 GHz cordless phones, microwave ovens, and other wireless networks. The cost for this type of network is \$69.99 per wireless card and \$99.99 per access point, with an installation fee of \$350.

The other wireless type is called type G wireless. This type is compatible with the type B wireless and also has the same coverage, but it uses the 5.8 GHz frequency and has a transfer rate of 54 mbps. The cost of the type G wireless is \$99 per wireless card and \$200 per access point, with an installation fee of \$350.


Installation Time
